Getting City Funding from the Federal Economic Stimulus Package

On Feb. 17, President Obama signed into law the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 commonly known as the Federal Economic Stimulus Package. The League of California Cities has compiled a [City Funding Book](#) to assist cities in pursuit of ARRA funding.
